

INSHORE FISHING TOURNEY

2nd ANNUAL MAY 2009

1. Time & Place: Tournament will start at 5:00 a.m. Saturday, May 9, 2009, and end at 6:00 p.m., Saturday, May 9, 2009 unless otherwise noted. Headquarters and weigh-in station will be the Chocolotta Bay Landing which is a public launch on the causeway.

2. Categories: Speckled Trout, White Trout, and Flounder.

3. Tickets: Tickets are \$25 per person. All persons in the boat must have a ticket. Pier fishermen are welcome to participate.

4. Conservation: Applicable state and federal laws (including fishing license) will be strictly adhered to in this tournament.

5. Weather: If a "small craft advisory" or worse is announced by the National Weather Service of Mobile during the 5 a.m. broadcast on May 9, 2009, the tournament will be canceled and rescheduled at a later date (to be determined by the committee).

6. Weigh-In: Only one fish entry per category will be allowed per angler. Fish entries can be weighed between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 9, 2009. Entries can be submitted to the weigh master only by the angler who caught the fish. Anglers must have their ticket stub to accompany their entry. In the event of a "boat traffic jam," all entries must be on the dock in view of a committee member or dock attendant no later than 6:00 p.m. Saturday, May 9, 2009. Committee members and dock attendants will be easily identified. Violation of this clause will disqualify those entries in question. No spoiled or rotten fish will be accepted. Entries that have been handled in an unsportsmanlike manner or mutilated will be disqualified. All entries must be caught on hook and line during the tournament hours, NOT BEFORE 5 a.m. Saturday, May 9, 2009.

7. Tie Breaker: In the case of a tie, the first fish weighed at the tournament scales shall determine the winner. Entry times will be recorded by the Weigh-In Committee and "first come/first served" basis will apply.

8. All decisions by the Rules Committee are FINAL. Any matter not specifically covered by these rules may be decided by and to the sole discretion of the Rules Committee.

9. Awards: Prizes will be given in each of the three categories from first through third place.

10. Awards Presentation: Immediately following the tournament, proceed to the awards presentation tent on the Chocolotta Bay Landing. At approximately 6:30 p.m. Saturday, May 9, 2009, the awards presentation will begin. All tournament awards will be distributed to the winners. If you are unable to attend the awards presentation, you may claim your prize by contacting the UCP office at 251-479-4900.

11. Liability: United Cerebral Palsy of Mobile, The Young Professionals Board of UCP, tournament committee members and volunteers shall not be liable for any bodily injury or damage to personal property before, during or after this tournament.
