Group Leaders: 8 positions available

The group leader will be responsible for supervising Jr. Group Leaders as well as providing care and guidance to the campers within their assigned team.

- Must be at least 18 years old

- Have at least 2 years experience as a camp counselor or in a related field.

Floaters/Substitute Group Leaders: 2 positions available

The Floater/ Substitute Group Leader will be responsible for supervising Jr. Group Leaders as well as providing care and guidance to the campers within their assigned team when a group leader is not able to attend camp according to the schedule. This team member will have additional duties that will be delegated by the Camp's Co-Directors as needed.

Group Leaders in Training Internship: 15 positions available

Within this internship, the Group Leader in Training will be responsible for providing care, assistance and guidance to the campers within their assigned group as well as following all directions and guidelines provided by the Co-Directors and Group Leaders. This is an unpaid internship with the opportunity to receive monetary bonuses throughout the camp season based on performance. College Credit can be provided.

- Must be at least 16 years old
- Must demonstrate willingness to work with children with all types of disabilities
- Have at least 1 year experience as a camp counselor or in a related field
- Must have a recommendation from a teacher and/or counselor/advisor to be considered

Therapy Assistants: 3 Physical Therapy/ 3 Occupational Therapy positions available

The therapy assistant will follow the directions and guidelines provided by our Physical Therapist and Occupational Therapist during the Morning Group Therapy program prior to Camp LivitUp. This is a flexible position that allows the assistant to work one day a week from 9-11 am.
